

## Polihali Dam Intake Structure Foundation Concrete Pour Underway



Construction of the Polihali Dam continues to make remarkable progress. We are pleased to share that the contractor is currently pouring the foundation concrete for the Polihali Dam Intake Structure. Once completed, the intake structure will rise to a height of approximately 112 metres from the foundation. It will have a base diameter of 40 metres, gradually narrowing to 20 metres at the top. The structure will be equipped with five intakes and two gates — one serving as a service gate and the other as an emergency gate.

Unlike the Katse Dam Intake Tower, which functions as a transfer intake tower that conveys water from Katse Dam to the 'Muela Hydropower Station, the Polihali Dam Intake Tower will be designed to manage downstream compensation, emergency releases, and environmental flows.
