

LHDA Rallies Staff as 40th Anniversary Activations Roll Out Across All Branches



The Lesotho Highlands Development Authority (LHDA) has begun rolling out its 40th Anniversary Activations, a series of Townhall sessions held across every Branch, bringing the whole organisation into the celebration of 40 years of the Lesotho Highlands Water Project (LHWP) and the start of the next 40.

Running from 22 June to 7 July 2026, the activations were officially launched under the leadership of Chief Executive Mr Tente Tente, Public Relations Manager Mr Mpho Brown, and Senior Public Relations Officer Mr Malakeng Hloma, who have been rallying staff across all Operations Branches to unite behind the endeavour and represent LHDA at its best as the celebrations gather pace.
