

Polihali Dam Rockfill Reaches Elevation 2020 as Phase II Construction Advances

In a significant milestone for Phase II of the Lesotho Highlands Water Project (LHWP), rockfill placement at the Polihali Dam has reached elevation 2020.

To date, 9.1 million cubic metres of rock have been placed, bringing rockfill works to approximately 65% completion, while overall dam construction now stands at 45% complete.



Work continues on major infrastructure components, including the intake tower, spillway, outlet tunnel, saddle dam, and concrete face slab construction.

The Project also continues to maintain a strong safety record, with zero fatalities recorded to date.

Once completed, the Polihali Dam will strengthen regional water security and deliver long term economic benefits for Lesotho.
