

RESETTLEMENT VILLAGES TAKING SHAPE ACROSS PHASE II

Construction of resettlement housing and village infrastructure for households affected by Phase II construction activities is progressing steadily.

Currently, 84 households from Tloha-re-Bue, Masakong, and Ha Tlhakoa are being resettled within the site establishment area, while work for a further 15 households from Tsekong is also advancing well.

Progress to date includes 45 houses under construction at Tloha-re-Bue, alongside a preschool and a church; 13 houses under construction at Masakong, alongside a preschool and a community hall; and 18 houses under construction at Tsekong (Lilimala), 14 of which have already been roofed.

Water supply systems are also being upgraded at Makalong and Ramonakalali to support relocated households and strengthen water reliability for surrounding communities.

The construction programme is expected to be completed in 2027
