



LHDA Expands Educational Outreach to Southern Region Schools



The Lesotho Highlands Development Authority (LHDA) continues to invest in the next generation through its educational outreach programme, which reached schools across southern Lesotho from 17 to 27 March 2026.

During this second round of engagements, LHDA visited 70 high schools—28 in Mphahle's Hoek and 42 in Mafeteng—bringing the Lesotho Highlands Water Project (LHWP) directly to learners.

The campaign focused on raising awareness about the project's role in water transfer, hydroelectric power generation, and national economic development. It also introduced learners to career opportunities linked to the LHWP, including engineering, environmental science, tourism, and development studies.

Recognising that many schools face financial constraints that limit educational visits to LHWP sites, LHDA partnered with the Ministry of Education to deliver interactive, in-school engagements. These sessions were met with strong enthusiasm from both learners and educators, with many expressing renewed interest in careers that contribute to Lesotho's development.

This initiative reflects LHDA's ongoing commitment to youth empowerment and long-term national capacity building.
